




### Mandarins/Soft Citrus: Over-maturity

#### Current requirement

- Table 1, 1(b)(ii): separation between the albedo and segments (rind separation)
- "Limited separation may occur as per annexure H"
- Annexure H (set 46A) reads:
  - Over-maturity for Soft Citrus allows a maximum colour print no. 3 for all varieties except for Late Satsumas, Late Clems and Late Mandarins which have a stricter requirement of colour print no. 2
- Current status re proposed amendment
  - In discussion to separate Sats/Clems from latematuring cultivars
  - Growers' Final proposal to be tested with Focus Group

### Next steps, on-going process ...

- Refine and re-assess inputs
- Discuss with PPECB re implementation
- Submit to the Executive Officer (DoA)
  - Note that there is no intention to promulgate new standards for 2025
  - The intention is to inform the Executive Officer of the proposed changes for future promulgation
- But proposed changes, if accepted by the Executive Officer, will be implemented by Industry-wide dispensation
